*Just Looking*

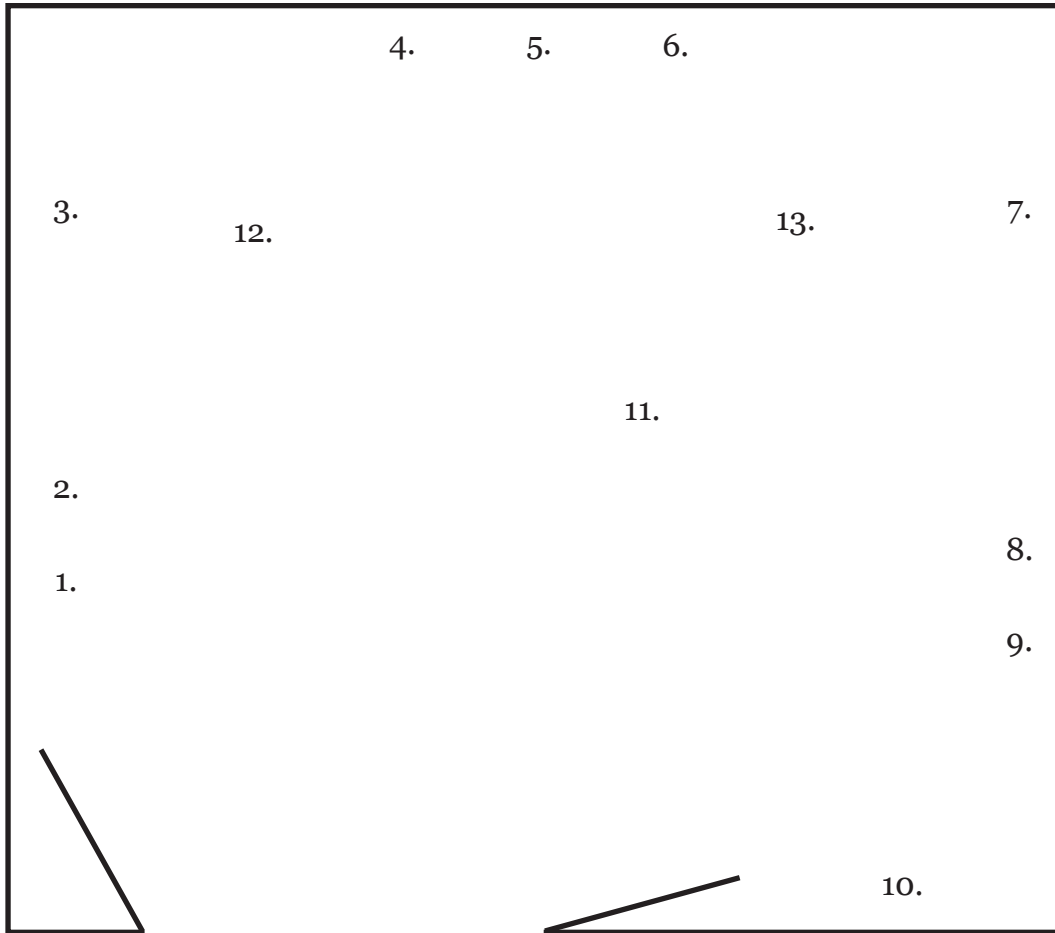
